BREAKING DOWN BARRIERS

Global University makes it possible for you to prepare for ministerial credentials regardless of where you live, work, or your commitments to career or family. The University strives to remove the barriers of time, space, past educational experience, and to a great degree level of income.

Time

Individualized study courses allow you to learn at your own pace. Flexible instruction frees you from the demands of specified class time and rigid institutional schedules. For undergraduate individualized study courses, there are no admissions deadlines; students may enroll year-round.

Space

The University can be wherever you are through our individualized-study packages. They include student manuals, study guides, textbooks, audiocassettes and online and live faculty support.

Previous Education

Any person, 18 years of age or older, is eligible for admission to Global University. Anyone may enroll in any course for personal enrichment regardless of previous academic experience. However, only high school graduates or those qualified under the admission policy may enroll in a degree study program.

Level of Income

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOOL OF BIBLE AND THEOLOGY

The School of Bible and Theology makes up the undergraduate program of Global University. The certificate and degree programs are open to all who have a high school diploma or its equivalent. For those with previous undergraduate training, transfer credit may be accepted. All of Global University's degree programs may be completed entirely by distance education. Global University's programs can meet the credentialing requirements of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada.

The Bachelor of Arts degree in Bible/Pastoral Ministries is designed to fulfill the educational requirements for ordination to the Christian ministry with the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada. After successfully completing this curriculum the student will be able to prepare and deliver sermons, administer programs in the local church, and function effectively as an ordained minister.

Qualified faculty develop Global University study guides in cooperation with the university's instructional development staff. ENROLLMENT

STUDENT NUMBER

Once we have received your completed enrollment card it is sent for processing to our International Office. They will in turn assign your student number. This process takes 3-4 weeks. In the meantime, please ensure that your complete name and address is on all correspondence.

PROJECTS AND ASSIGNMENTS

All courses contain a project that is worth 20% of your final grade. Your course may also contain a Collateral Reading Assignment that also has a value of 20% of your final grade.

All course work must be submitted before the course deadline or a mark of zero will be assigned. Students have 6 months to complete each course. Please ensure that your student number is written on all assignments submitted for grading.

Plagiarism:

A project is considered to contain plagiarism if:

- It contains work in whole or in part, done by an individual other than the person submitting the project.
- It contains work in whole or in part, taken from another source without proper reference to the original source.
- The entire work has been copied from another source.

Disciplinary Actions for Plagiarism

When plagiarism has occurred the following policy will be followed:

- The student will be advised in writing that plagiarism has been discovered.
- First offence: the project will be returned to the student to be re-written.
- Second offence: the project will receive a failing grade (maximum of 40%).
- Third offence: the student will fail the course.

TESTS AND EXAMS

Unit Tests in the Student Packet are to be completed and marked by the student using the answer key provided in the Student Packet. These tests do not count towards your final grade, but are important in evaluating your progress and preparing you for the examination.

Upon completion of the course, please send us the "Request to Take Final Exam" form found in your Student Packet. Please send us this form at least three weeks in advance of the date you wish to write your exam. On this form you will list the name and complete mailing address of your Exam Supervisor. You may make arrangements with your Pastor, Church Secretary or Board Member. Your Exam Supervisor must not be related to you and must not be a current student of Global University.

You and your Exam Supervisor will determine the date, time and location that the exam will be completed.

COURSE DEADLINE

The time limit for completion of a Global University course is six (6) months. You are encouraged to complete your studies within this prescribed length of time.

If you are unable to meet this deadline, the International Office, may, upon recommendation of the National Director, grant an extension. Extensions must be requested before the original expiration date of the course. The maximum time granted for an extension is six (6) months. If you do not complete the course before the extended expiration date, you must pay for re-enrollment into the course in order to receive course credit.

To request an extension, please complete the Course Extension form found on the GUC website (<http://www.globaluniversity.ca/>) and send it to our office at least 4 weeks in advance of your deadline.

FINAL GRADES

All final exams are sent on a weekly basis to the International Office for processing. Final grades are calculated using the results from your exam, your project mark and if required, the Collateral Reading Assignment.

Your final grade will be forwarded to you approximately 4-6 weeks after your exam arrives in our office.

TRANSCRIPTS

You may request a transcript of academic record at any time during your course of study. The International Office issues all transcripts, whether official or unofficial. Transcripts released directly to you will be marked "Copy," "Issued to Student," or "Unofficial." "Official" transcripts are sent by the International Office directly to other institutions as requested by the student.

A signed Transcript Request form, which is available on the GUC website, must be submitted to the International Office before an official or unofficial transcript can be issued.
